Reptiles In The Riverina Highlands

Dr Damian Michael, Senior Research Ecologist and Herpetologist with the Fenner School of Environment and Society, The Australian National University, is the guest speaker for Riverina Highlands Landcare Network's annual winter warmer dinner.

For the past two decades, the ANU has been conducting long-term research on woodland reptiles throughout the South-west Slopes of NSW, with a particular focus on understanding where these secretive animals live in farming landscapes.

Only in recent years have we been able to understand their habitat preferences and response to farming management practices. Much of this work is published in Damian's latest book "Reptiles of the Murray catchment: A guide to their Ecology, Conservation and Management", which will be available on the evening.
